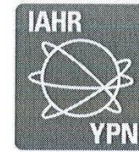


## Objectives for the mandate 2019 – 2020

The five main objectives of the Executive Committee of the PT-YPN-IAHR for the 2019-2020 mandate are established with the purpose of increasing the visibility of the PT-YPN-IAHR and the engagement between academia researchers and industry engineers in Portugal. The objectives are:

### 1. CREATE A WEBSITE AND IMPROVE SOCIAL MEDIA NETWORKS

A new website will be created in order to share and promote the work carried out within its social and professional activities, or by its members and supported projects. The website will:

- Present the history, aim and vision of the PT-YPN-IAHR.
- Present the objectives of the current mandate.
- Present the Executive Committee team.
- Present the members of the PT-YPN-IAHR.
- Promote future events and plans for PT-YPN-IAHR and its members.
- Promote collaborations and announcements of scholarships and research projects.

To support the website and increase the engagement with the community, social media networks will be created, such as Twitter and LinkedIn, and the Facebook account will be updated.

### 2. DEVELOP A BI-ANNUAL NEWSLETTER

A bi-annual newsletter will be developed for establishing a periodic way of contact with members and non-members across the country, as well as to develop a serious international promotion of our activities. The first Newsletter will present the new Executive Committee, the objectives of the mandate and the activities of the present years.

### 3. INCREASE NUMBER OF MEMBERSHIPS

The Executive Committee pretends to increase its memberships by 50% (nine new members). The increase in memberships should be achieved through out the dissemination of Portugal YPN as well as the promotion of members' benefits. Members' benefits should contribute to increase the knowledge sharing in the field of hydro-environment engineering; research and enhance professional skills.

### 4. FOSTER ACTIVITIES

Foster activities aim to promote and provide opportunities for YPN members and if possible other young professionals to have closer contact with hydro-environment engineering and research. The proposed activities for the current mandate are:

- One session for young professionals in the XVI Ibero-American seminar of supply and drainage systems (SEREA2019).

- A set of four technical sessions with further debate with members of the academia and industry entitled "Hydro-environment Monday talks".
- Participation in five events to promote PT-YPN-IAHR. These events can be conferences, courses or workshops.

## 5. DEVELOP PARTNERSHIPS


A partner category will be created to establish partnerships with Portuguese companies and, consequently, reduce the gap between hydro-environment researchers and engineers. These partnerships will promote benefits to the organization and to its members by supporting the proposed activities. Partnerships can include research units and universities, engineering and modelling companies and other organizations. Also, the executive committee aims at collaborating with YPN networks from other countries to increase the dissemination of the PT-YPN-IAHR.






